Albert L. "Bud" Perry, 85, of Bettendorf, IA, formerly of West Alton, MO, passed away peacefully at his home on Sunday, September 10, 2017 after a courageous battle with cancer. Burial will be at Ebenezer Cemetery in West Alton, MO. Albert was born February 1, 1932 to Albert W. and Mariette (Keene) Perry in West Alton, MO. He married A. Evelyn Springer on April 15, 1950; she went to be with the Lord March, 1973. He married Shirley Goettsch on September 15, 1973. He worked for Alcan and Lou's Service Station, Alton and several truck lines including Burlington, Hannibal-Quincy and Tucker, St. Louis, as well as Smith Transfer and Deutz Tractor Co., Davenport, IA.
