Alfred "Al" Taylor, 66, died at 7:16 a.m. Friday, February 8, 2013 at St. Anthony's Hospital in Alton after a lengthy illness. Born April 9, 1946 in Jerseyville, he was the son of Lawrence Raymond and Lena Mae (Goodman) Taylor. Mr. Taylor was a U.S. Navy Veteran of the Vietnam War and was a member of the VFW Post 1308. He was a member of the Abundant Life Community Church. He was an avid reader and loved music and singing in the church choir and gospel groups. He retired as a millwright from the Olin Corporation. After retirement he loved to tinker and repair things and was a fix it all man. On May 24, 1968 he married the former Carolyn S. Glisson in Corcoran, CA. She survives.
