Alice Ann "Sani" Varble, 92, died at 10:37 a.m. Tuesday, August 26, 2025 at La Bella of Alton. Born March 20, 1933 in St. Mary's, Pennsylvania, she was the daughter of Ralph E. and Martha (Hanes) Lawson. She was a member of St. Ambrose Catholic Church in Godfrey and retired from Alton Memorial Hospital, Alton as a Nuclear Medicine Technician in 2002. Mrs. Varble was a professional opera singer and sang with the Midland Repertory Players.
