Arlan "Frank" Mir, 82, died at 1:42 p.m. Saturday, May 3, 2014 at St. Anthony's Hospital in Alton. Born August 23, 1931 in Durango, Colorado, he was the son of William and Irene (Kettler) Mir. Mr. Mir served in the U.S. Air Force. He was a former member of the Alton Eagles F.O.E. no. 254, the Elks Lodge 2316 in Florissant, MO and was a 3rd Degree Knight with the Knights of Columbus in Bunker Hill. He worked for McDonnell Douglas as director of manufacturing, retiring in 1989 after 36 years of service. During the years of 1992-1995 he then worked as Vice President of operations on the B2 Bomber in Palmdale, CA at Northrop Grumman. Since 2005 he had enjoyed spending the winter months in Pharr, TX. On March 27, 1976 he married the former Phyllis Wright. They celebrated their 38th wedding anniversary in March of this year. Along with his wife he is survived by three sons, William C.
