Betty J. Wuellner, 92, died at 8:35 a.m. Tuesday, January 4, 2022 at her home in Godfrey. Born June 23, 1929 in Alton, she was the daughter of August and Kathaleen (Lipple) Purcell. She graduated from Notre Dame Academy in Belleville, IL. On December 30, 1947 she married Frederick A. Wuellner at SS Peter & Paul Catholic Church in Alton.
