Carl T. Markovitch, 89, died at 12:20 p.m. Thursday, January 17, 2019 with his three children by his side. Born April 19, 1929 in Wood River, he was the son of Ignatius and Lura (Brodie) Markovitch. He was a faithful member of SS Peter & Paul Catholic Church in Alton for over 68 years. Carl graduated from Marquette Catholic High School in 1947 and was a very proud Army veteran. He was active in St. Vincent DePaul Society, a life long member of Knights of Columbus and an avid Notre Dame fan. He was employed by Standard Oil, Metropolitan Life Insurance Company and in his retirement drove a bus for the Madison County Transit (MCT). On April 7, 1951 he married the former Betty Smith in Alton. She preceded him in death on May 17, 1994. Surviving are three children, Don Markovitch (Lou Ellen) of Springfield, IL, Ann Henkhaus (Vic) of Wood River, and Jeanne Rynders (Tim) of Godfrey, grandchildren: Rebecca Elliott (Mike), Brian Saenz (Kristen), Rachel Waters (Brandon), Danny Rynders (Justine), Jenna Rynders (Chad); great grandchildren: Elizabeth Butkus (Ben), Samantha Elliott, Maddie and Katie Saenz, and Eli and Simon Waters and a special nephew, Joe Markovitch.
