March 6, 1917 - May 20, 2013

Caroline Korilko, 96, passed away at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, May 20, 2013 at St. Clare's Hospital in Alton. She was born March 6, 1917 in Granite City, IL, the daughter of Louis and Lydia (Vargo) Kocsis. On May 6, 1939 she married her husband, John Korilko.
