Charles "Chucker" R. Tague, 93, died at 7:22 p.m. Sunday, December 22, 2024 at Alton Memorial Hospital. Born October 4, 1931 in Alton, he was the son of Ray D. and Victoria (Panyik) Tague. Mr. Tague retired from Union Local 688. He was a bronze level ABC Bowling Coach and coached the Alton High School bowling team. He was a member of the Bowling Hall of Fame. On August 3, 1953 he married the former Loretta May Medlock in Alton. She preceded him in death on October 16, 2010. Surviving are two daughters, Victoria R. Prairie of Godfrey and Mary E. Busler (Dale) of Godfrey, and a daughter-in-law, Lynn Tague of Champaign, IL.
