Clarence W. Williams, 87, died at 9:35 p.m. Sunday, February 19, 2012 at Blue Fountain Manor in Godfrey. Born October 22, 1924 in Biloxi, Mississippi, he was the son of Fred and Evelyn (Gollott) Williams. He served in the U.S. Navy during WWII. He worked as a machinist engineer on a riverboat before taking a job with Laclede Steel. He retired from Laclede in 1981 as a maintenance supervisor after 20 years of service. On June 13, 1948 in Biloxi, Mississippi, he married the former Shannon Breal. She preceded him in death on May 24, 1990. Surviving is a daughter, Beth Ann Williams of St. Ann, MO, a son and daughter-in-law, Don and Nancy Williams of Alton, two grandchildren, Lisa Loncaric (Michael) and Christopher Williams (Christi), four great grandchildren, Max and Mia and Alex and Zach, one brother, Richard Eldon Williams of Ft.
