



Cletus "Squeak" Hayes Jr.

Cletus W. "Squeak" Hayes Jr., 96, died at 7:30 a.m. Saturday, February 27, 2021 at Alton Memorial Hospital. Born August 15, 1924 in Kane, IL, he was the son of Cletus W. Hayes Sr. and Edna (Witt) Hayes. Mr. Hayes was a WWII Army Airborne Veteran and was a life member of the VFW Post 1308. He was also a member of Lodge 951 of the Moose in Alton. He retired as a lab inspector for the Olin Corporation after 45 years of service. On July 31, 1948 he married the former Betty Lu Johnston in Alton. She preceded him in death on January 24, 2015.
