Clifford Edler, 82, died at 9:09 a.m. on Friday, February 24, 2017 at his residence. He was born July 8, 1934 in Portage De Sioux, MO the son of Edward and Clara (Sprick) Edler. After retirement, he went to worked for 13 years for Laborers Union 660 of St. Charles, MO where he was a member for over 50 years. Also surviving are two sons; David Edler (Terri) of Godfrey, IL and Steve Edler (Janine) of South St. Louis, MO, four grandchildren; Christopher, Sarah, Garrett and Connor Edler.
