Reverend Doyle D. Miller, 83, died at 2:00 a.m. Thursday, March 17, 2011 at Alton Memorial Hospital. Born October 17, 1927 in Nortonville, KY, he was the son of Ruby Lloyd and Oshie Elizabeth (Hill) Miller. He was a pastor at the First Church of God in Rittman, Ohio and at the Alton First Church of God. He also worked at Central Hardware in Alton and at General Motors in Detroit. On January 28, 1949 in Belding, Michigan, he married the former Ayme Joy Thompson. She survives.
