Edward "Ed" Meyer, 55, died at 5:08 p.m. Wednesday, February 12, 2014 at Alton Memorial Hospital. Born May 16, 1958 in Alton, he was the son of William Meyer of Godfrey and the late Darlene (Dewanz) Meyer. He was a Captain with American Commercial Barge Line for 16 years. After retiring from ACBL he became owner/operator of Clay East Supply, Inc. in Godfrey. He married Monica Thomeczek on July 26, 2005. She survives.
