Emma K. "Kitty" Holt, 89, died at 5:27 p.m. Saturday October 5, 2013 at her home in Godfrey. Born February 21, 1924 in Nilwood, IL, she was the daughter of the late Clarence E. and Bessie Bell (Boston) Sharp. Mrs. Holt was a member of the Godfrey Congregational Church and a former member of the Women's Auxiliary at Owens-Illinois. She worked at Sears and Venture as a retail clerk before retiring in 1978.
