Everett Raymond Greene, 99, died at 2:10 a.m. on Friday, January 10, 2014 at Alhambra Care in Alhambra, IL. He was born December 29, 1914 in Jefferson County, IL the son of the late Bert and Stella (Clark) Greene. He was a member of the SeaBees during WW II. He retired in 1967 as a machine tender with Alton Box Board. After retirement, he went on to be the owner and operator of the Wood River and Alton Dairy Queen and Raymond's Gun Shop in Alton and he was a commercial fisherman for years. His passions were hunting, fishing, golfing and the St. Louis Cardinals. On May 10, 1935 in Salem, IL he married Mable M. Cooper and she preceded him in death November 15, 1981. He went on to marry Roanna Simpson and later Selma Leigh, both preceded him in death.
