Everett Allen Phillips, 92, died at 11:22 a.m. Thursday, August 16, 2012 at Jersey Nursing & Rehab. in Jerseyville. Born June 16, 1920 in Berdan, IL, he was the son of Herman and Laura (Book) Phillips. He served in the U.S. Air Force during WWII. He retired from Olin Brass as a mold tender in 1982 after 42 ½ years of service. On January 2, 1941 in Troy, MO, he married the former Alta Mae Moore. She preceded him in death on July 23, 2011.
