December 16, 1943 - June 25, 2018

Fred Secor, 74, passed away peacefully with his family by his side at 10:50 a.m. Monday, June 25, 2018 at his home in Collinsville. Born December 16, 1943 in Alton, he was the son of Fred H. "Ted" Secor Jr. and Minnie Mae (Caldwell) Secor. Fred served as a Navy Seabee during the Vietnam War. He was a member of the Alton VFW Post 1308 and the Community Christian Church.
