February 14, 1916 - August 26, 2011

Freda I. Wright, 95, died at 6:00 p.m. Friday, August 26, 2011 at Rosewood Care Center in Alton. Born February 14, 1916 in Godfrey, she was the daughter of Frank P. and Grace J. (Doty) Boker. She graduated from Brighton Community High School in 1934. Freda was a member of SS Peter & Paul Catholic Church and a member of the Altar Society. She was also a member of the American Gold Star Mothers and the VFW Post 1308 Ladies Auxiliary and volunteered as a Pink Lady for St. Anthony's Hospital. On May 20, 1939 in Alton, she married Clyde T. Wright. He preceded her in death on March 4, 2002.
