Gerald Dee Hise, 87, died at 3:06 p.m. Sunday, June 11, 2017 at his home in Alton, surrounded by his loving family. Born September 15, 1929 in Ridgeway, IL, he was the son of Earl Dee and Arizona (Fulks) Hise. Mr. Hise served with the U.S. Army during the Korean War. He was a member of the Abundant Life Community Church in Alton, formerly Edward Street Assembly of God, where he served as a deacon, Sunday School teacher, bus driver, Royal Ranger Leader and also on the visitation team.
