Getsel M. Bright, 89, died at 9:25 p.m. Monday, March 5, 2012 at Alton Memorial Hospital. Born July 23, 1922 in Fairmont, West Virginia, he was the son of Clarence and Esta (Canfield) Bright. Mr. Bright served in the U.S. Air Force during WWII and was a member of the College Avenue Presbyterian Church in Alton. He retired as a mold maker from Owens Illinois Glass in Alton after 42 ½ years of service. He was a lifetime member of the VFW Post 1308 and the Alton Wood River Sportsman's Club. On June 9, 1962 in Alton, he married Nell Hodges. She survives. Also surviving is a daughter, Judy Ann Bellitto of Alton, five grandchildren, Jimmy Gaither, Tina Gaither, Angie Uzzetta, Tony Bellitto, and Michael Gaither, 22 great grandchildren, one great-great grandson, and a sister, Lucille Adams of Scottsdale, AZ. He was preceded in death by his parents, a daughter, Hazel Ruth Sheppard and a son-in-law, Bill Bellitto.
