Gloria June Schrumpf, 92, passed away at 5:11 a.m. Friday, August 9, 2024 at Alton Memorial Hospital. Born October 20, 1931 in Nokomis, IL, she was the daughter of Matthew and Marie (Prammer) Kausic. After graduating from St. John's College of Nursing in

Springfield, IL, she married Roy E. Schrumpf and moved to Wood River, IL.

Her nursing career spanned 45 years, including as a surgical nurse at St. Joseph Hospital, office manager for doctors Moore, Lynn and Donnelly, staff nurse at both St. Anthony's Hospital and the Visiting Nurse Association, and the director of nursing at the senior care facility at Christian Northeast.

Along with her parents and husband, she was preceded in death by three sisters, Marion Andrews, Rudy Raymond, and Helen Krisciunas.
