



## Herman L. Boren

December 13, 1931 - November 26, 2023

Herman L. Boren, 91, died at 2:25 p.m. Sunday, November 26, 2023 at Jerseyville Manor. Born December 13, 1931 in Omstead, IL, he was the son of Evelyn (Hise) Carter.
