Herman "Pete" Kochersperger, 98, died at 3:27 p.m. Wednesday, January 8, 2020 at his home. Born December 15, 1921 in Alton, he was the son of William Jake and Dora Mamie (McKenzie) Kochersperger. Pete served in the U.S. Navy during WWII and was a member of the Evangelical United Church of Christ in Godfrey. He retired from the Teamsters Union as a fuel oil deliverer. On July 15, 1947 he married the former Arline Reardon in St. Louis, MO. She preceded him in death on December 3, 2012. Surviving is a daughter, Jeannine Erlhoff of Boulder, CO, three grandchildren, Tim, Mike and Todd Eller, and several nieces and nephews. Along with his parents and wife, he was preceded in death by a son, David E. Kochersperger and a daughter, Mary Eller. Visitation will be from 10:00 a.m. until time of funeral service at 11:00 a.m. Thursday, January 16, 2020 at Evangelical United Church of Christ in Godfrey. Reverend Jerry McCaskey will officiate.
