Janet “Jan” Leigh Campbell, 64, died Monday, April 2, 2018 at Christian Hospital North East. She was born June 22, 1953 in Alton the daughter of the late Eldon Lee Smith and Dorothy (Clayton). She worked as a graphic artist for Emmons Printing for 22 years before working for Schwartzkopf Printing for over 20 years. She was a 35-year member and past national president of the Phi Tau Omega Sorority Delta Chapter, a board member of the Oasis Women’s Center and Caravan Resale shop, Alton High School class of 1971 reunion committee, a supporter of the 5A’s Animal Shelter, past board member of YWCA in Alton, past board member of the United Way and past member of the Riverbend Growth Association. On August 18, 1973 in Alton she married Kenneth “Kenny” Campbell and he survives.
