Jeanette Mae Jacoby, 88, died peacefully at her home on January 27, 2021. Born in Alton, Illinois on January 25, 1933, she was the daughter of Charles Herman and Agnes Elizabeth (Boyd) Luft. She married Dr. Robert Paul Jacoby on April 8, 1961 at Upper Alton Baptist Church. He preceded her in death on July 14, 1997.

Jeanette was a longtime member of First Presbyterian Church where she was active in numerous positions, most notable coordinating flowers for many years. She was a volunteer in the White Cross Auxiliary at Alton Memorial Hospital working in the gift shop for over 30 years and was a member of P.E.O. Chapter GG in Alton. She enjoyed many years boating with her beloved husband, Bob, on the Mississippi river belonging to the Hide-a-Way Yacht club. There she spent

many weekends, timing sailboat races and enjoying potlucks, parties, and friendship. She enjoyed the companionship of her terriers over the years; Ginger, Trixie, Daisy and Holly. She also enjoyed watching and feeding birds in her backyard and gardening, creating ever expanding gardens. She had an enchanting personality and generous heart, bringing much joy and love to her family and countless friends and acquaintances.

Her home, in her words, was her heaven on earth. Her husband, Bob, was the love of her life, whom she missed dearly since his passing, and she is now with him again.

Surviving are two sons and daughters-in-law, David and Janet Jacoby and Stephen and Louise Jacoby all of Godfrey.
