John E. "Jack" Seibold, 90, died at 6:12 p.m. Tuesday, January 24, 2017 at his home in Godfrey. Born January 30, 1926 in Alton, he was the son of Julius and Nellie (Harrington) Seibold. He attended SS Peter & Paul Catholic School and served in the U.S. Navy until he was honorably discharged in 1946. He was a lifetime member of the VFW Post 1308, a member of the Knights of Columbus and a member of St. Ambrose Catholic Church where he served as an usher. He was an avid golfer and enjoyed spending the winter months in Florida. He retired from the quality control lab of Shell Oil Company in Roxana after 37 years of service.
