Karen J. Lohr, 72, of Godfrey, died at 9:30 a.m. Sunday, June 10, 2018 in the Emergency Room at St. Anthony's Hospital in Alton. She was born in Long Beach, CA on June 3, 1946 to Lorene (Essary) Sileven and the late Harold Sileven. She married Wesley Gene Lohr on February 20, 1965 at St. Ambrose Catholic Church in Godfrey. He survives along with their children, Terry (Shelly) Lohr and Renee (Rob) Brown, four grandsons, Michael, Matthew, Mark and Noah Brown and a granddaughter, Kari Lohr. Also surviving are two sisters, Marilyn Sileven of Orlando, FL, and Teresa (Bob) Tripp of Godfrey. She collected Elvis and Robert Wadlow memorabilia and enjoyed eating out with her W-R '64 classmates.
