Larry Dean Henson, 78, died at 3:09 p.m. Thursday, August 29, 2024 at Alton Memorial Hospital in Alton, IL. Born March 2, 1946 in Adrian, IL, he was the son of Eukely E. and Retta Faye (King) Henson.
