Larry T. Spain, 92, died at 3:25 p.m. Wednesday, June 14, 2023 at Alton Memorial Hospital. Born February 22, 1931 in Cedar Falls, Iowa, he was the son of James M. and Margaret (Larson) Spain. Larry graduated from the University of Iowa and served as a lieutenant in the U.S. Army. He was a member of St. Ambrose Catholic Church in Godfrey and was a longtime, proud member of the Alton Godfrey Rotary Club. Larry enjoyed reading, golfing (hole in one in Destin, FL) playing bridge, watching all sports especially the St Louis Cardinals, cheering on his Iowa Hawkeyes, traveling with Shirley, and attending his grandchildren's events.

He retired as regional manager for Illinois Bell/A T & T. On June 9, 1956 he married the former Shirley J. Janssen in Iowa City, Iowa. She preceded him in death on October 10, 2019.
