Linda Boehler, 77, passed peacefully on Sunday, March 29, 2026, at her home with her children by her side. She was brave in the face of a brief illness, having very recently been diagnosed with incurable lung cancer. She was born June 10, 1948, on the farm where she grew up in Godfrey, Illinois. Linda was the daughter of the late Joseph and Eunice (McDow) Stiritz. Linda worked as a loan processor for many years with Olin Employees Credit Union. Linda was a loving mother to many, a great cook, and enjoyed traveling and the occasional glass of wine. She was a member of First Presbyterian Church in Alton.
