Loyal M. "Bud" Case, 91, died at 3:12 p.m. Saturday, January 25, 2014 at Rosewood Care Center in Alton. Born April 21, 1922 in Detroit, MI, he was the son of Loyal W. Case Sr. and Helen M. (Auno) Case. He served in the U.S. Navy during WWII and was a member of the VFW Post 1308 in Alton. He retired from the process engineering department at the Olin Corporation in 1982 after 40 years of service. On October 12, 1946 he married the former Clara A. Sampson.
