Lyndel Lee Hopper, 82, died at 2:09 p.m. Monday, July 14, 2025 at Jerseyville Manor. Born September 15, 1942 in Athensville, IL, he was the son of Glenn and Edna (Duckwiler) Hopper. Mr. Hopper served in the U.S. Army and retired in 1997 as supervisor of gas operations for Union Electric, where he worked for 30 years. On November 23, 1963 he married the former Kay Louise Warren in St. Louis, MO. She survives.
