



Mary Yvonne "Voni" Hoefert

October 22, 1930 - May 1, 2025

Mary Yvonne "Voni" Hoefert, 94, died with her family by her side, at 9:03 a.m. on Thursday, May 1, 2025. Born October 22, 1930, in Edwardsville, Illinois, she was the daughter of Leonard W. and Blanche (Edwards) Kesl. Voni married John Werner Hoefert on October 3, 1953.

Voni's family and her Catholic faith were of the utmost importance to her. She was always available to assist anyone in need and knew no limitations, regardless of the request. She found comfort in praying the rosary.

For many special moments in the lives of her family and friends, Voni had a gift for words, often writing heartfelt poems, leaving a legacy of love and memory. Voni's personality transcended positivity on a daily basis.
