Mary Corrine Murphy, 96, died at 5:30 a.m. Monday, January 10, 2011 at Alton Memorial Hospital. Born June 29, 1914 in East St. Louis, IL, she was the daughter of Camile and Zelia (Chartrand) Etienne. She was a charter member of Lockhaven County Club and participated in the women's golf group and was also a member of the Alton-Florida Golf Group with Lockhaven.
