Morris "Pete" Lee Ervin, 82, died at 8:20 p.m. Thursday, January 10, 2019 at Jerseyville Manor Nursing Home. He was born August 19, 1936 on Brookside Avenue in Alton, the son of Bluford and Dorothy (Ackerman) Ervin. Pete retired as a captain from the U.S. Marine Corps in 1975 after 22 years of service.
