Nancy A. Weaver, 76, died at 4:45 a.m. Tuesday, December 22, 2020 at Barnes Hospital in St. Louis, MO. Born December 17, 1944 in Wood River, she was the daughter of Louis and Anna (Wooden) Milazzo. She retired as a special education teacher in 2004.
