Phyllis B. Dickerson, 97, died at 6:45 a.m. on Thursday, February 22, 2024 at her residence. She was born November 18, 1926 in Alton, the daughter of the late Glen and Helen (Wightman) Butler. She worked for many years as a sales clerk with Godwin Office supplies and was a member of Upper Alton Baptist Church. Phyllis was known to always be the winner at dice and marble games with her family. She enjoyed being outside tending to her flowers. Was known as the "Cookie Lady" at Asbury Village, where she would often greet new residents with fresh cookies. She always had cookies for family and friends. She was an avid reader and Hayner Public Library would make regular book deliveries to her. On July 22, 1945 in Alton she married Kenneth Dickerson and he preceded her in death.
