Ray was born January 12, 1926 in Mexico, KY the son of the late Cavit and Vada (Teer) Rogers. He graduated from Francis High School in April of 1944.

On April 27, 1944 he was inducted into the U.S. Army where he served with great patriotic pride in a quartermaster depot company in the Philippines and Japan during WWII. He was honorably discharged in May of 1946 as a

Sergeant. He went on to graduate from Evansville College in 1951 with a BA in secondary education with a business major and a history minor. In July

1951 he went to work for Standard Oil of Indiana in Evansville, IN then he transferred to Wood River, Cape Girardeau, MO and back to Wood River. Ray

work. He retired from Amoco Oil as a fleet director in January of 1986. Ray
