Rev. Robert Lee Mathes Sr., age 86 died at 3:05 PM on Thursday, October 4, 2018 at John Cochran VA Hospital in St. Louis. Born in East St. Louis on October 5, 1931 he was the son of the late Dalton Shelby and Emily Etta (Hudson) Mathes. Robert was a US Navy Korean War veteran and a member of Abundant Life Community Church in Alton. He began his professional life as a music and choral teacher in various school systems, pastored in Nashville, IL and Granite City, IL and was currently the Sr. Adult Pastor at Abundant Life Community Church in Alton. He married the former Katherine Alice (Talbot) on September 18, 1955 and she preceded him in death on January 19, 2014.
