Roberta J. Schroeder, 89, died at 12:45 a.m. Thursday, December 6, 2012 at the Fountains IV in Godfrey. Born July 4, 1923 in Godfrey, she was the daughter of Frank and Hattie (Ebbeler) Roberts. She was a longtime member of the Evangelical United Church of Christ in Godfrey. During WWII she worked for the Olin Corporation and later worked in the cafeteria at the Fosterburg grade school. She was a wonderful homemaker, mother, and cook. In 1942 she married Lester Schroeder in Brighton. He preceded her in death on May 16, 1997.
