Roger David Brandt Sr., 78, died Wednesday, May 24, 2017 at Alton Memorial Hospital. Born June 23, 1938 in Ottumwa, Iowa, he was the son of Frederick and Gladys (Space) Brandt. He served in Vietnam with the U.S. Army and as a recruiter later (22 years) in all. He then worked for Olin Brass Mfg. as a security supervisor, retiring after 18 years of service.
