Dr. Roland Edward Schoenborn, 82, died at 1:37 AM Sunday, November 6, 2011 at his home. Born in Cleveland, Ohio, he was the son of Reinhold and Lydia (Lother) Schoenborn. He served in the US Air Force in the US and overseas from 1949 to 1953. On June 13, 1958 in Alton, he married the former Veronica Elder. She survives.
