Roy Dale Ferguson, 83, died at 4:53 p.m. on Friday, February 14, 2014 at Blu-Fountain Manor in Godfrey. He was born December 17, 1930 in Moose Lake, Minnesota the son of the late Bertha (Probst) Ferguson. He was a platoon sergeant in the Army during the Korean War. He retired from Illinois Bell as a lineman and foreman. He went on to be owner and operator of Alton Fence and Door and retired in 2007. He attended Faith Lutheran Church in Godfrey. He enjoyed wintering in Florida during his retirement years. On June 7, 1957 in Alton, he married Thelma Stanka, who he met at the Alton Water Ski Club and she survives.
