Stephen Schrimpf, 72, died at 5:25 p.m. on Saturday, January 8, 2022 at Alton Memorial Rehab. He was born on August 29, 1949 in Alton, the son of the late Edward and Marcella (Baker) Schrimpf. He graduated in 1974 from the University of Arkansas with a Juris Doctorate degree and while there he served in the U.S. Navy Reserves from 1968-1970. He last served as General Counsel for Joseph E. Meyer & Associates in Edwardsville, IL. from 1990 to present. Stephen was a loving husband, father, grandfather and brother. He loved spending time with his family, friends and pets, and he loved his motorcycles, his cars and especially, "Old Red", his 1949 Chevy truck which he bought from its original owner. On August 5, 1980 in Alton, he married Mary Hazel and she survives.
