Ted S. Kornegay, 83, died at 7:35 p.m. Sunday, August 6, 2017 at his home in Godfrey. Born October 28, 1933 in Centreville, Alabama, he was the son of Claude B. and Ruth (Miller) Kornegay. Ted was an Airman 1st Class in the U.S. Air Force serving in Japan during the Korean War. He was a member of the Masonic Lodge #46 in Wentzville, MO and was an active member of the First United Methodist Church of Godfrey. He loved to play golf. He retired from Millers Mutual Insurance Company as Vice President of Claims. On May 26, 1956 he married the former June Wigger in St. Louis, MO. She preceded him in death. Surviving are three sons, Steve (Nancy) Kornegay of North Richland Hills, TX, Tim (Beth) Kornegay of Bellevue, Washington, and Joel (Laura) Kornegay of Las Vegas, NV, seven grandchildren, Ted, Jane, Nathan, Ruthie and David Kornegay, Lisa Kring and Jenny Withrow.
