Virginia Lee Fohrman, 93, passed away peacefully, Saturday morning, May 28, 2022 at Alton Memorial Rehabilitation and Therapy. The family moved to Alton where she attended and graduated from Alton Senior High School. She also attended Shurtleff College after graduation. Virginia married William B.
