June 12, 1916 - December 30, 2010

Walter Frank Carver, 94, died at 12:40 p.m. Thursday, December 30, 2010 at Rosewood Care Center in Alton. Born June 12, 1916 in Metropolis, IL, he was the son of Daniel M. and Minnie (Hammond) Phelps. He retired from Owens Illinois Glass in Godfrey on September 29, 1978 as a machinist. He was a member of the Civilian Conservation Corps and an avid hunter and fisherman. On August 2, 1942, he married the former Garnet Lillie. She preceded him in death on January 22, 1999.
