Wilbert Eugene Evans, 88, died at 10:32 a.m. Sunday, March 3, 2019 at Alton Memorial Hospital. Born November 9, 1930 in East Alton, he was the son of Reverend Claude Evans and Sadie (Lawson) Evans. Mr. Evans was a truck driver for Schulte Supply in Edwardsville and was a member of Calvary Baptist Church in Alton. A "jack of all trades," Mr. Evans was an avid woodworker and enjoyed fishing and hunting. On November 14, 1969 he married the former Julia Barr in Bethalto. She survives.
