He owned and operated Bill's Hobby Shop from 1953-1980. After closing the hobby shop he sold cars and insurance for a few years. Most recently he worked for 8 years at Lambert International Airport as a TSA agent. He married Donna M. Browning on February 10, 1962 in Alton and she survives.
