William John "Shorty" Narup, 84, died Monday, August 7, 2017 at Christian Hospital in St. Louis, MO. Born July 17, 1933 on the family farm in Godfrey, he was the son of Helen (James) Kingsbury and Carl Narup. Mr. Narup graduated from Marquette Catholic High School in 1952. He served in the U.S. Navy from 1953-1955 and sailed on the USS Kearsarge. He retired as a machinist from the Olin Corporation.
